



# DROUGHT RATE INCREASE NOTIFICATION

Myoma Dunes Water Company (MDWC) enacted water restrictions in June 2022 to comply with California’s emergency conservation regulations. The Governor and the State Water Resources Control Board’s regulations require MDWC to reduce overall water use by **15%**.

Help SAVE 15% and **skip overseeding** to avoid drought penalties, save costs and water!



MDWC has so far seen a cumulative savings of 6.8%! We still need help from our customers to reach the state’s goal.

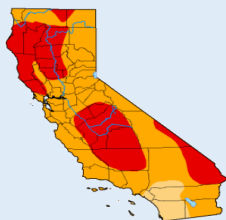
Continuing with Level 2 of our Water Shortage Contingency Plan, MDWC has adopted drought penalty rates to encourage conservation by reducing outdoor water use. These rates will reflect on the September 2022 billing period.

Customers who do not meet the conservation target will pay the drought penalty rate for water use in **Tier 3** and **Tier 4**.

## HOAs & “Non-functional Turf”

Watering non-functional lawns in commercial, industrial, and institutional areas, including common areas of homeowners’ associations is prohibited until **June 2023**.

Grass in common areas of HOAs, if not recreational or protective of trees and shrubs, is subject to the State’s prohibition on irrigation.

## PROHIBITED WATER USE EFFECTIVE UNTIL JANUARY 2023

### What wasteful water uses are prohibited?

Using potable water for the following activities:

- Outdoor watering that lets water run onto sidewalks and other areas (except incidental runoff)
- Washing vehicles without an automatic shutoff nozzle
- Washing hard surfaces like driveways or sidewalks that don’t absorb water
- Street cleaning or construction site preparation
- Filling decorative fountains, lakes, or ponds
- Outdoor watering within 48 hours after it rains at least 1/4 inch of rain-fall
- Watering ornamental turf on public medians
- Spray/sprinkler irrigation during daylight hours
